The radioactive plume from the Fukushima meltdowns overlaid on the location of the Indian Point Nuclear Power Plant

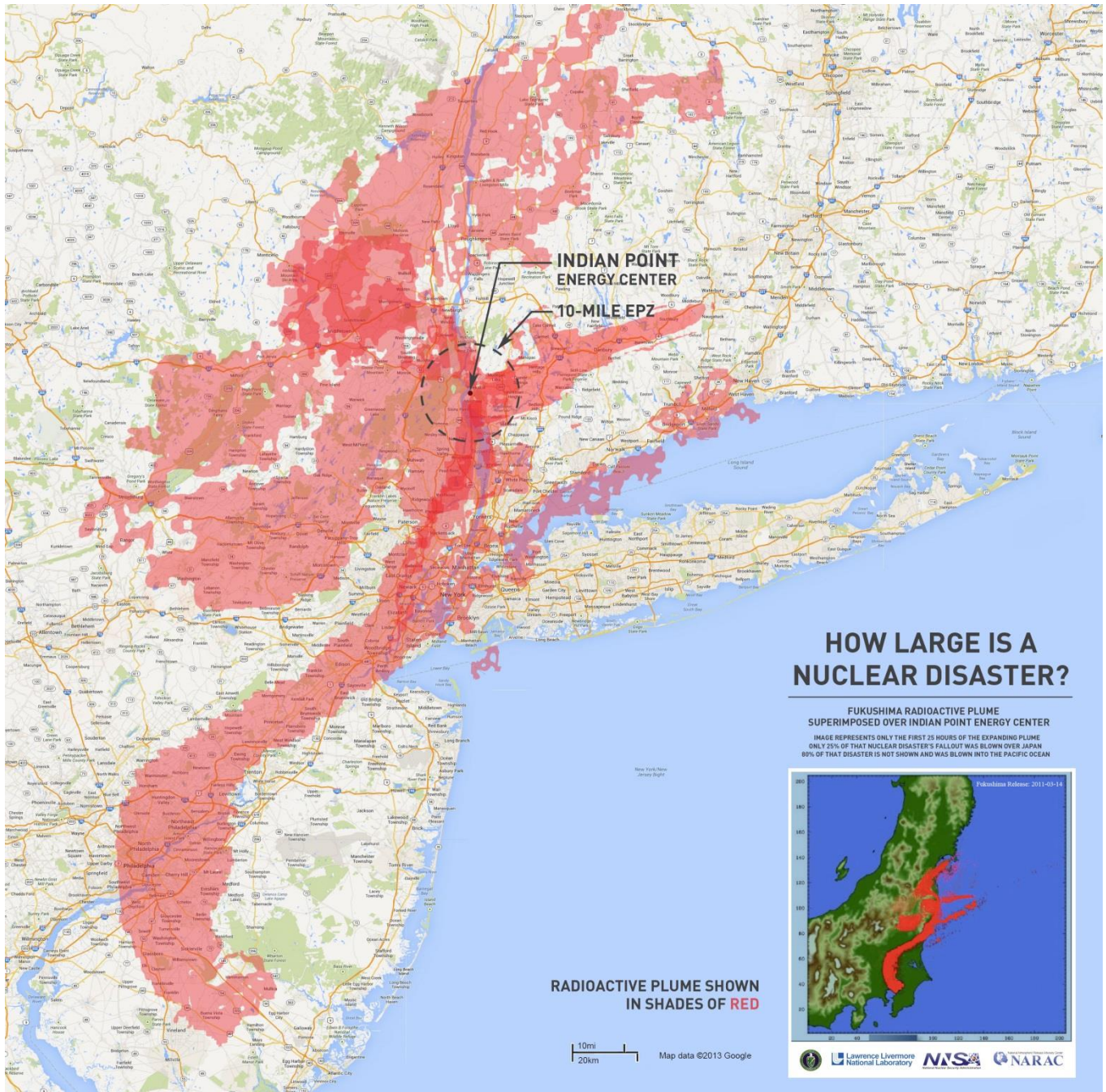

The U.S. Government advised Americans within 50 miles of the Fukushima Dai-ichi nuclear plant to evacuate. All five boroughs of NYC are within 50 miles of Indian Point, but there is no emergency planning for such a nuclear accident.

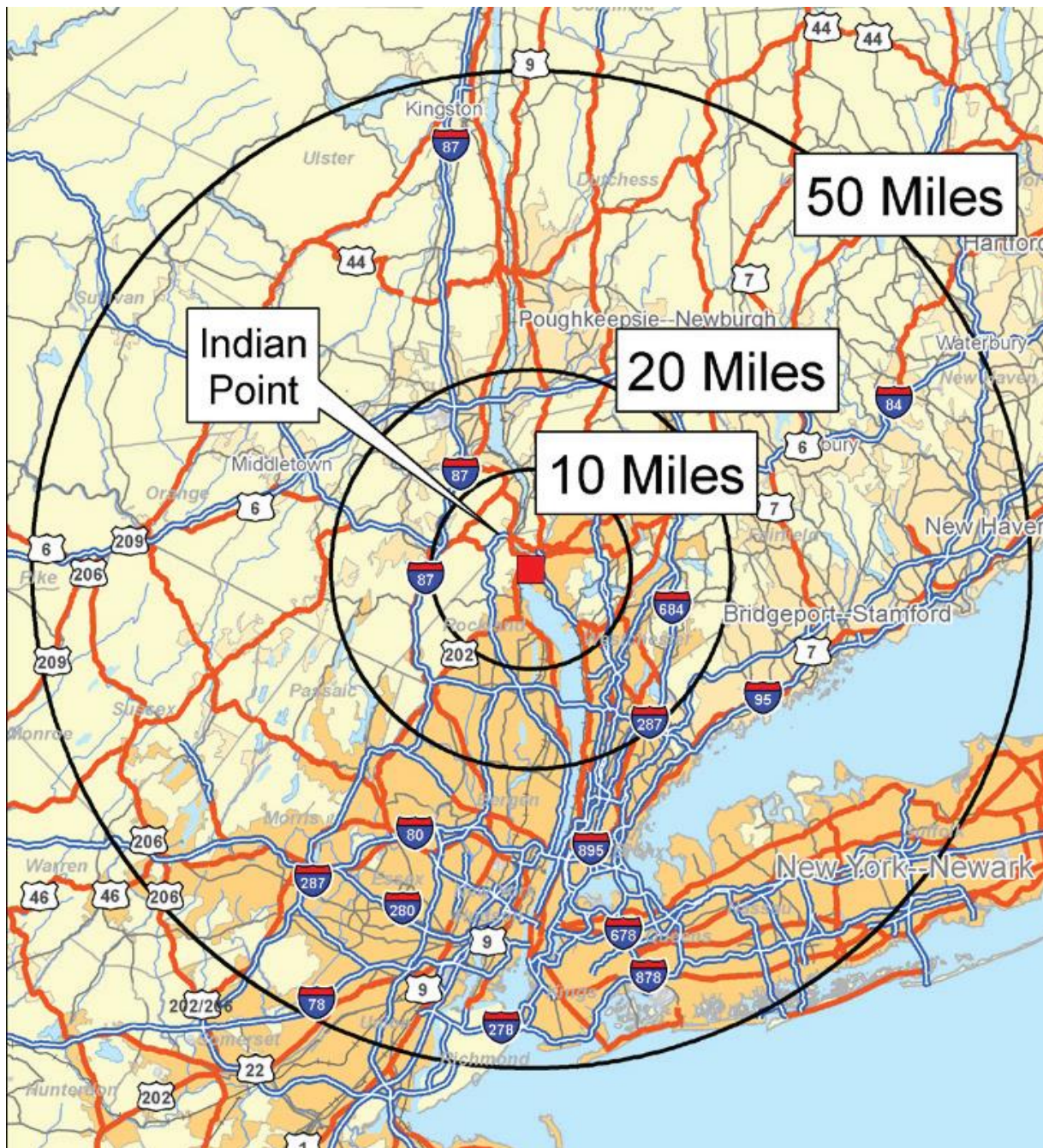
